Landfill Hazards:

- Dust
- Methane
- Toxic solid waste leachate liquids discharged into Black Run
- Accepting/using construction and demo material which generates hydrogen sulfide, "rotten egg smell"

Tri-County's Track Record: Tri-County and its parent company have been fined over \$1.5 million for solid waste violations over the past 10 years. These include leaking waste trucks, mismanagement of leachate, improper storage of unapproved waste, transporting unapproved oil and gas residual waste, accepting non-permitted hazardous waste, and chronic odor control problems. PA DEP Protection's NW Regional Director: "Seneca landfill (Vogel Holding) has been lax in following the environmental regulations that direct how municipal landfills are required to operate."
